1. Burn?

Why burn? because you have not loved the Lord your God with all your heart, and you have not loved your neighbour as yourself.

Every day you just sell to make money and don't care whether another person has paid too much, or bought something useless. You don't want to share the profits, but sell as high as possible, without thinking about the other person. Do you love them? You can sell them cigarettes just to make money, even if it's unhealthy. You'll sell alcohol only because it serves your own interest of making money. Not because you care what happens to the drunkard. Look at this. You're not doing it to help the other person. Do you pretend that you love your neighbour as yourself? You cannot.

You'll use adultery to sell clothing. Yes, you'll put a woman wearing very little clothing on your poster so that men think about sex. Yes, you do this, not to help men. NO! Your only objective is to make money. Can you pretend you love them? Can you pretend that you want men to be faithful to their wives? Lay aside your mask and write your name SATAN on your signboard.

You may spend hundreds of dollars for the best fashion to regularly show off yourself. But isn't this just because you want people to look at you and see how pretty you are? In fact, prettier than others? Thus you trample on others and steal hearts away, instead of leading hearts to God. It is no wonder then, that you must burn.

You don't care how many people you trample on, to climb up the ladder of your career. As long as you're the winner, you don't care who the loser is. Are you serving your fellow man? Are you loving them the way Christ loved you and gave his life for you? Certainly not. How then, can you claim to love others? Hypocrite! Isn't this what God requires? It is no wonder that you must burn.

Politics. Do you love the other party as your own? Or do you exaggerate their faults and enlarge your virtues just to get the vote? Is this loving them as yourself? No.

You love applause. Is this humble? You appear to serve other people, but it's only for them to be better supporters and to bring even more customers, or to have more friends. You may be nice and loving, but it's only for you in the end. You don't do it because you love others, or God.

You love your family, but is this loving God? Is this loving God who gives you breath and money and all these things? No, you cannot pretend to love God the

same way that you love your family. He made you. You don't love him even to read a bible. You don't help others know about him at a church, and you pray only when facing danger to save your skin. This is why you must burn.

BOOK OF CONFESSIONS

Please confess clearly by reading BURN and writing your sins down in the BOOK OF CONFESSIONS.

Sinners do not like the holiness of God. That is why they have remained sinners so far.

If sinners loved the holiness of God, they would repent of all their sins.

An unrepentant sinner is someone who does not like holiness, therefore he does not aim for holiness.

He loves his sins more than he loves God.

He will not love to be holy because he does not love the holiness of God.

A sinner may love God for other reasons, for example, because God can meet his needs.

However, a sinner does not love God because he is holy. Otherwise he would no longer sin.

A sinner has not been converted from his sins, he does not love holiness, but he loves his sins.

When we say a person is converted, it means he no longer loves his sins, but he hates his sins.

How do you feel about your sins?

Are you afraid to break off from your sins?

If you stop the sin, outwardly, you have not been converted, because inwardly you still love your sins.

Are you afraid to confess your sins, because you know you will go back to them again?

Then you are not converted. A converted person no longer wants to sin.

If you do not love the holiness of God, then you actually hate God, and you are still on the road to hell.

If you still want to sin, then you have not been converted.

You need to be more full in your confession, and you must believe God sent Jesus to purify you from your sins

"Break up your fallow ground: for it is time to seek the LORD, till he come and rain righteousness upon you." Hosea 10:12

Now you must draw off your attention from all other things and look into this right now. Do not be in a hurry. Look at your life, consider your motives and actions. . . call up your past and see its true character. Look back over your past history. Take up your individual sins one by one, and look at them. This doesn't mean that you just take a casual glance at your past life, see that it has been full of sin, and then go to God and make a sort of general confession, asking forgiveness. General confessions of sin are not good enough. Your sins were committed one by one; and as much as you are able, they ought to be reviewed and repented of one by one. It's a good idea to take a pen and some paper as you go over them, and write them down as they come to mind.

Go over them as carefully as a businessman goes over his books; and as often as a sin comes to your memory, write it down -

SINS OF OMISSION

1. INGRATITUDE - Take this sin, for example, and write down under it all the times you can remember where you received kindness from God but never gave thanks. How many situations can you remember - some Godordered events that saved you from ruin? Write down when God was good to you and you were only halfthankful - when you were in sin before your conversion, the circumstances of your turning to God. List the numerous mercies he has given since. How many are the instances where your ingratitude is so shameful that you run to hide your face? Now on your knees confess to God these times one by one, and ask forgiveness. Confession will suggest others to your memory. Write them down. Go over your list three or four times in this way, and you will find an astonishing number of mercies for which you have never thanked God.

UNTHANKFUL:
2. LACK OF LOVE TO GOD - Write that down, and review all the times you can remember when you didn't give to the blessed God the fervent love he deserves. Think how dismayed you would be if you discovered even a slight wavering of affection for you in your wife, husband, or children - if you saw somebody else capturing their hearts, thoughts and time. You would nearly die with a righteous jealousy! In a far greater way God is a jealous God. Have you given your heart to other loves and infinitely offended him with your adultery?
LOVE FOR GOD:

3. NEGLECT OF THE BIBLE - Put down the spans when for days, even weeks or months, you disdained God's word. If you read it, you did it in a way that was more displeasing to God than not reading at all. Many people read a whole chapter in a way that they couldn't tell what they just read. They pay so little attention that at night they don't remember where they read in the morning unless they use a bookmark or turn down a page corner. This demonstrates how little they take to heart what they read. If you were reading a book or a magazine that fascinated you, wouldn't you remember what you read last? And the fact that you need a bookmark shows that you read as a chore rather than from love or reverence for the word of God. The word of God lays out your duty. Do you regard it so lightly that you forget what you read? If that is the case, it is no wonder that you live so randomly and that your spiritual life is such a miserable failure. YOUR LACK OF LOVE FOR YOUR NEIGHBOURS' SOULS - Look around at your friends and relatives and remember how little compassion you have felt for them. You stood by and watched them go to hell, and it seemed you didn't care if they did. How many days have gone by when you didn't even think of their condition and pray a single fervent prayer for them - or even have a burning longing for their salvation?

7. THE WAY YOU HAVE PERFORMED THOSE DUTIES - without feeling or faith, with an ungodly attitude - so that your words were just chatter. When you have fallen on your knees and said your prayers so mindlessly that five minutes later you didn't know what you prayed.

	9. YOUR LACK OF CARE FOR THE LOST - Maybe you haven't cared enough to try to learn about them - not even to read a missions magazine. Examine how much you really care about the unreached and their salvation. Measure your desire for their salvation by the self-denial you practice in giving what is yours to send them the Gospel. Do you deny yourself even the harmful luxuries such as tea and coffee? Do you curb your lifestyle or live any less conveniently to save them? Do you pray daily for them on your own, and do you consistently attend prayer meetings for missions? Do you save something from month to month to give at special offerings for missionaries? If you don't do these things, and your soul does not agonize for the blinded unbelievers, why are you such a hypocrite? Why pretend to be a Christian? Your claim to be a Christian insults Jesus Christ!

What do you think of yourself if you claim to love Christians and to love Christ, even though you can watch them slide into disgrace and say nothing to them?

SINS OF COMMISSION

1. A MIND SET ON MATERIAL THINGS - What is your heart's attitude towards your possessions? Do you think of them as really yours, as if you had a right to do with them whatever you want? If you do, write it down. If you have loved property and sought after it to satisfy lust or ambition or to save it for your families, you have sinned and need to repent. WORLDLY:	proud. Vanity is one form of pride - how many times have you been vain about how you look? How many times have you spent more time decorating your body to go to church than you have in preparing your mind to worship God? You have gone to God's house caring more about how you look on the outside to human beings than how your soul appears on the inside to the heart-searching God. You have exalted yourself to be worshiped by them, rather than preparing yourself to worship God. You divide the worship of God's house, drawing the attention of God's people to your striking pose. You can't pretend that you don't care about having people look at you. Be honest about it. Would you be so picky about your looks if everyone were blind?

	and if you have given room to this spirit of hell, repent deeply before God or he will never forgive you.

7. LYING - Understand what lying is: any deliberate deception. If the deception isn't intentional, it isn't lying. But if you plot to give an impression different from the	CHEATING:
naked truth, you lie. Put down all the times you can	
recall. Don't call them anything less than what they are. God calls them lies and charges you with lying. You had	
better charge yourself correctly. How uncountable are the lies told every day in business and society by words,	
looks, and actions - each designed to leave an impression different to the truth!

Or cases God of your own talents, but you have tied the hands of where you wasted talents and intellect, where you threw another. What a sinful servant is the one who is lazy away money on your lusts or spent on things you didn't himself and hinders the rest! This is sometimes done by need and which increased neither health, nor comfort, wasting their time, sometimes by destroying confidence nor usefulness. Perhaps some have shelled out God's in them. You have played into Satan's hands and not money on cigarettes. If you have committed a fault against someone and that person is within your reach, go and confess your wrong immediately and get your sin out of the way. If the person you have injured is too far away to go and see him, sit down and write a letter and confess the injury. If you have cheated anyone, send the money - the full amount, with interest.

Work thoroughly in this. Do it now. Putting it off only makes things worse. Confess to God sins committed against God, and to man sins committed against man. Don't think of getting off by dodging a difficult point. Take everything and put it out of the way. In breaking up your stony heart, you must remove every stone and every matted clump of earth.

Don't leave things you think are only little things and then wonder why you don't feel committed to God. The reason will be that your pride has buried something God said you must confess and remove. Don't turn aside for little difficulties; drive the plough straight through them, plough deep and turn up all the ground so that it is soft and well broken up, fit to receive seed and bear fruit and hundredfold.

When you have reviewed your whole history in this way - thoroughly - then go over the ground a second time and give solemn, close attention to it. The things you have written down will suggest other things you have been guilty of. Then go over it a third time, and you will recall other things. And at the end you will remember an amount of your past - even particular actions - that you didn't think you could ever remember. Unless you examine your sins one by one, you can never grasp the amount of your sin. You should go over your life as thoroughly as you would prepare for judgment.

SURRENDER YOUR SINS

As you go over the lists of your sins, determine to make immediate and entire change. Wherever you find anything wrong, decide at once, by the strength of God, to not sin again in that way. It benefits nothing to examine yourself unless you resolve to change every single wrong you find in attitude or conduct.

If as you attempt to break up your stony heart, you find your mind is dark, look around. You will find there is still some reason why God's Spirit departs from you. You haven't been faithful and thorough. In this process you must be violent toward yourself and apply your mind.

With the Bible in front of you, examine your heart until you do feel. Don't expect God to work a miracle for you to break up your stony heart. The labour is to be done by you.

Focus your attention on your sins. You can't look at your sins very long or very thoroughly and see how bad they are without being deeply moved. Experience abundantly proves the benefit of reviewing our lives in this way. Go to work now. Resolve that you won't stop until you find you can pray. You won't ever have the spirit of prayer until you examine yourself and confess your sins and break up your stony heart. You won't ever have the Spirit of God dwelling in you until you unravel you whole history of sin and spread it out in front of God.

If there is this deep work of repentance and full confession, this breaking down before God, you will then have as much of the spirit of prayer as your body can withstand. Few Christians know anything about the spirit of prayer because they never painfully examine themselves, and so they never know what it means to be completely broken in this way.

3. WHY ARE YOU BACKSLIDDEN?

- 3.1 CONFESS Search for an idol. Find out what you love more than God Wealth, a friend, fashionable dress, the popular crowd or a favourite amusement. Your heart is so fixed, you won't yield to God
- 3.2 CONFESS Search for someone you have injured in a way that calls for redress. Unwilling to confess and make it right. Hurt a person's property or character or have abused them. There is no hope for you until you are willing to confess it and do the right thing
- 3.3 CONFESS Look for a sin you won't forsake. It doesn't matter how small it is, you can never enter God's kingdom until you give it up
- 3.4 CONFESS See if there is restitution left undone. Swindled or took advantage of someone in business. You can never have forgiveness until you pay back the money

Doctrinal Errors

Believing a lie that the Bible commands us to leave sin bit by bit - we are rather required to break from it instantly and completely

Waiting for God for more conviction. You don't need to have monstrous fears of hell

Waiting for identical emotions someone else experienced. You can't predict the way God leads you

Trying to make yourself better (humiliation, suffering, prayer)

Thinking your sins are too enormous for God to forgive. Thinking God has abandoned you and it is too late to be saved. Thinking you have committed the unpardonable sin

Looking to your own darkness instead of looking to Christ.

3.5 CONFESS Look where you have been stubborn:

Not allowing yourself to be "reconverted"

Not willing to attend a particular meeting or Not willing to pray with a certain individual

Not writing your sins down

Saying that you can be come back just as well without doing it that way, because Christianity does not consist in going to a certain meeting, or having a designated attitude.

As long as you remain stubborn and determine to sway God to your terms, you will never be brought back.

- 3.6 CONFESS Look out for a member of the Church you dislike because he spoke the truth to you bluntly. Uncover it and accept the truth plainly. You will never be brought back until you lay it down.
- 3.7 CONFESS Look out for resentment. This keeps you from receiving God's mercy

4. FALSE COMFORTS FOR SINNERS:

- 4.1 You're not so bad. What have you ever done to need to feel so bad? As if he has never done anything evil and has no reason to feel distressed
- 4.2 Conversion is a progressive work NO, beginning is never progressive
- 4.3 Don't think about it now Just because God gave you time, it doesn't mean that He will give him time.
- 4.4 Don't be discouraged. I was the same way a long time before I found rest.
- 4.5 Christianity is cheerful! It isn't gloomy. Don't be distressed, be comforted, forget your fears True, it isn't just feeling bad. But the sinner has reason for distress, because he doesn't have Christian faith.
- 4.6 You can never fully understand repentance and regeneration The Bible gives a clear view of the nature and duty of repentance.
- 4.7 You are not to blame for your sin This is comfort full of death
- 4.8 What can you do to save yourself? You're a poor, feeble creature. You can't do anything The sinner thinks, God certainly can't send me to hell for not doing something I can't do The relief is counterfeit and it only stores up wrath for judgement day
- 4.9 Wait on God's time This is untrue because he has a part to do that no one else, including God, can do for him
- 4.10 Have your worship time The sinner is willing to do anything else, except repent now. His burden rolls away
- 4.11 Pray for a new heart unless they have faith and pray in faith
- 4.12 Persevere this encourages sinners to hold out longer in rebellion
- 4.13 Statements based on the belief that the sinner faces heaven, when in fact he faces hell: Press forward or You're on the right path, just press on and you'll get to heaven
- 4.14 Try to repent and give your heart to God Sure, I've tried before and I'll try again, the sinner says
- 4.15 You haven't repented enough The truth is that the sinner hasn't repented at all.
- 4.16 If you are elected, God will bring you into His fold You cause the sinner to rest in apathy.
- 4.17 Pray for repentance, Pray for conviction, Pray for the Holy Spirit to show you your sins, Try to get a better sense of your guilt rather tell him to restore all the money he stole (if applicable) and be reconciled to the people he misused
- 4.18 I have faith you will be converted Your purpose should rather be to annihilate every last vestige of hope while he remains in sin.
- 4.19 I will pray for you, You are doing well, I feel encouraged about you, Do what you can, and God will take care of the rest
- 4.20 Applying Scripture promises only meant for saints Blessed are those who mourn, Seek and you shall find, Let us not lose heart in doing good
- 4.21 God has begun a good work in you and He will complete it.
- 4.22 Describing your own conversion causes him to try and copy your experience instead of following the Gospel or the Spirit's leading in his own soul.

5. A LOVER OF THE WORLD

Give up the world to God, and he will give it right back to you - NO, God never gives the world back to the Christian in the same way that He requires the sinner to give it up

God requires the sinner to give up the world, and in the same way he requires the Christian to give up the world forever

5.1 CONFESS You tempt the world to follow fashion and be prideful

5.2 CONFESS You do not surrender ownership of everything to God, to never again consider something your own

REMEMBER: He that forsaketh not all that he hath cannot be Christ's disciple

Unless we entirely consecrate ourselves to Christ - time, talents and influence - we will never get to heaven If we don't use our energies for God, when we die we will find hell at the end of the path we pursued

6. WITHOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT

The Holy Spirit is given to those that obey God.

Christians are guilty for not having the Spirit as sinners are for not repenting.

Christians have more light, and so more guilt.

Every human on earth has the right to complain about Christians who don't have the Spirit

6.1 CONFESS You roadblock God's work. Pastors can't work around you

6.2 CONFESS You live a hypocritical life, your prayers are apathetic and insincere. You are insincere in your interactions with others

6.3 CONFESS You live with so much lightness and never settle down to take anything seriously

6.4 CONFESS You are so proud, so engrossed with clothing, the good life and the latest of everything

6.5 CONFESS Your mind is glued to the world. You love property and try so hard to get rich. Getting rich absorbs your whole life

6.6 CONFESS You don't fully confess and forsake your sins. You confess your sin in broad terms and are always ready to admit that you are a sinner. You confess a particular sin partially, with reserve, pride and guardedness

6.7 CONFESS You ignore a duty, such as family prayer, or you pursue a temporal goal and shirk your calling

6.8 CONFESS Your heart fights the conviction when you hear a sermon which touches your situation

6.9 CONFESS You don't wholly want the Spirit. It will take too many sacrifices. Some things you aren't willing to give up. You are unwilling to live a different life, give up the world, break with your ungodly friends and fully confess your sins. You secretly want Him to give in to your terms, but He will never do that

7. A WEAK PRAYER LIFE

Millions are in hell because the people who profess to be Christians have not offered the prayer of faith.

The church is under a monstrous load of guilt because of the blood of souls lost through their lack of faith. At the judgement, the promises of God still unpacked from their Bibles will stare at them in the face and drag them down to hell.

7.1 CONFESS Neglect of the Bible. You have not searched for evidence that God wants to bestow the blessing. You have not found a general or specific promise or prophecy to stand on when you pray. Go through the Bible, it is full of them.

- 7.2 CONFESS You have not nurtured the good desires you have. You do not cherish or protect the smallest longing that you have. You get distracted by inappropriate lightness, by faultfinding or by setting your heart on the world, and you do not follow up your benevolent feelings.
- 7.3 CONFESS You are not entirely consecrated to God, living a holy life, giving everything to God--all you have and all you are, time, talents, influence. You do not set apart times to renew your covenant and freshly dedicate yourself to God. Not admitting that you need to be 'reconverted'
- 7.4 CONFESS You don't pray for the Spirit, or you pray and make no other effort or action to take hold of Him.
- 7.5 CONFESS You do not continue to pray until you have taken hold of the blessing.
- 7.6 CONFESS You do not walk every day with God, so he doesn't tell you what to pray for.

8. HINDERING REVIVAL

- 8.1 CONFESS You have not been convicted of your sins
- 8.2 CONFESS You have not begun in obedience to God and forsaken your sins
- 8.3 CONFESS You have little or no faith, cannot feel for sinners, are blind to them, and do not really see the burning realities of eternity
- 8.4 CONFESS You therefore cannot pray
- 8.5 CONFESS You also have not overcome the world and sin, and do not see the salvation of sinners happening around you
- 8.6 CONFESS You do not see the need to unite with other Christians to pray for revival
- 8.7 CONFESS You have not preached that men should repent
- 8.8 CONFESS You have not preached in a way that requires sinners to immediately convert from their sins
- 8.9 CONFESS You don't see the Providence of God His ordering of events that signal an awakening is at hand. You don't believe that God cares
- 8.10 CONFESS You are not grieved, humbled or distressed by the sinfulness of sinners. You don't mind the sinfulness around you
- 8.11 CONFESS When you see sinners, you scold at them, or talk about them so coldly that it seems you have no desire to see reformation
- 8.12 CONFESS You don't have the spirit of prayer for revival. Or you pray as if you don't really want it
- 8.13 CONFESS You have not begun to confess your sins to other Christians specifically and in a concerned manner
- 8.14 CONFESS You are not willing to sacrifice to carry on the revival. You have not really counted the cost, because you are not willing to surrender feelings, business and time to help the work

9. QUENCHING THE SPIRIT

- 9.1 CONFESS When the Spirit arrives and begins to reorder your life, you grieve Him away and refuse to walk with Him.
- 9.2 CONFESS You are not willing to be called eccentric. You have not made up your mind to be peculiar and act in ways that appear strange to those who don't comprehend the reasons behind your behaviour
- 9.3 CONFESS Ashamed that people think you are deranged when you deviate from what people think is common sense
- 9.4 CONFESS You do not feel great distress over the church and the world. You just seek the Spirit to feel content

9.11 CONFESS You will not have a calmness and cheerfulness when under severe afflictions and trials

9.12 CONFESS You are not peaceful in death. You do not want to be in a position where you are always

ready to die

10. FIRSTLY, REPENT OF ALL YOUR SIN. BE TOTALLY HONEST IF YOU ARE BACKSLIDDEN:

- 1. Remember where you have fallen from
- 2. Take to heart your conviction about your true position
- 3. Repent at once
- 4. Don't try to return merely by reforming your outside conduct. Saying 'The Lord's Prayer' to cover up your sin is not going to help:
- 5. Don't attempt to recommend yourself to God by unrepentant works or prayers
- 6. Don't fool yourself that you are in a justified state. Come as you are to Christ, owning up, taking all the shame and blame on yourself. Come at once, like a guilty, condemned sinner. Don't make a single excuse, but just confess it all. Believe that despite your wanderings from God, He loves you still
- 7. Come to Christ immediately. Believe that "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9

11. COMMIT YOURSELF TO CHRIST:

- 1. Once you have confessed your sins and sicknesses, believe that Jesus died so that you can be completely forgiven and healed (You must first confess your sins before you can be forgiven)
- 2. Once you have committed yourself by confessing online at www.JesusGod.org then go to the person you have sinned against and confess your wrong immediately and get your sin out of the way. If the person you have injured is too far away to go and see him, sit down and write a letter and confess the injury. If you have cheated anyone, send the money the full amount, with interest.
- 3. Pray to take your eyes off your own glory, look out only for God's glory, finding acceptance with Him through Christ.
- A. CONFESS Be dead to flattery or condemnation. Confess pride or shame to pray or do anything in public
- B. CONFESS Accept the whole will of God with a greater and greater love for it. Confess rebelling against His will revealed in His Word or in His ordering of circumstances
- 4. Be calm in hardship from having a soul firmly anchored in Christ
- 5. Have tranquillity in the face of sudden, crushing disasters and losses
- 6. Have patience under provocation

- 7. Decide to endure patiently and joyfully when God's will calls you to suffer under crosses, disappointments and severe pain
- 8. Have an increasing deadness to all the world offers or threatens
- 9. Resist the temptation to complain when disappointed. Decide to find rest and satisfaction in the allotments of God's ordering hand
- 10. Resist temptation to worry
- 11. Resist temptation to resent and retaliate when you are insulted or abused. Have smaller and smaller self-consciousness and respect for self in every action in life
- 12. Resist temptation to focus on troubles or talk about them to others. This shows that you persistently think of self and reject your trials out of constant rebellion against God
- 13. Decide to not focus on your trials more than on your blessings
- A. CONFESS Quit your anxiety about life's circumstances, especially the things you cherish. Quit your persistent tendency of serving self. If childlike faith in you is not increasing then confess it
- 14. Don't be troubled about events that thwart your plans, hopes, expectations and desires
- 15. Have confidence in the wisdom, goodness and universality of God's providence. Have a state of mind that sees God in absolutely everything
- A. CONFESS Resist constantly dwelling on others' faults and shortcomings
- B. CONFESS Confess speech that remains sarcastic, uncharitable or severe instead of gentle, delicate and tender in speaking of others' real or supposed faults
- C. CONFESS Stop thinking of or treating other people as enemies. Confess if it remains difficult to treat them kindly, and if you cannot pray for them heartily and work to do them good
- D. CONFESS Confess an inability to forgive. Stop any desire to hold grudges
- 16. Immediately abandon all sectarian discriminations, all prejudices of caste, colour, poverty, riches, blood relation. Immediately join with God to do good to enemies and friends alike
- 17. Be willing to make great sacrifices with wholehearted joy for those who hate you, to promote their eternal salvation
- 18. Stop seeing anything you do for God or the souls of men and women as a sacrifice
- 19. Stop being more inclined to focus on your trials, losses and crosses
- 20. Openly confess to those you have injured. Lay your heart open to God's searching and conviction. Is it a trial more than a joy to own up and confess? Don't carry on with your life while the fullest confession and restitution within your power remains undone
- 21. Decide to live gratefully. Have a deep appreciation for the kindness of God and anyone else who shows you kindness
- 22. Have an increasing earnestness to follow on to know more of the Lord as revealed in the scriptures
- A. CONFESS Confess where you are not readily quickened by spiritual truth. Where your whole being does not harmoniously accept and rest in God's whole will and providence. This might be too painful for you
- 22. Have a growing jealousy for God's honour, for the church's purity, and for the good of all people
- 23. Remember that every step of spiritual progress must be made by faith, not by works. Take hold of Christ by faith. Be emptied of self-dependence. Stop holding onto expectations of forming holy habits through your own obedience. Decide to partake by faith of deeper and deeper baptisms of the Holy Spirit
- 24. Quit the erroneous and dangerous idea that we grow up spiritually by forming holy habits. Don't begin zealous outward work without developing your inward life. Learn how to appropriate Christ and derive life from Him. All work is worthless unless it proceeds from the life of God in your own heart
- 25. Exercise faith that works by love, that purifies the heart and overcomes the world.
