SPIRITUAL WARFARE PRAYER SCRIPTURES

Joshua 1:9 <u>Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage</u>; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest. Joshua 10:25 And Joshua said unto them, <u>Fear not, nor be dismayed</u>, be strong and of good courage: <u>for thus shall the LORD do to all your enemies against whom ye fight</u>. 2 Chronicles 16:9 For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, <u>to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is perfect toward him</u>. Herein thou hast done foolishly: therefore from henceforth thou shalt have wars.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you <u>power to tread on</u> <u>serpents and scorpions</u>, and <u>over all the power of the enemy</u>: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but <u>be ye</u> <u>transformed by the renewing of your mind</u>, that <u>ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.</u>

- 1 Corinthians 10:13. There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but **God is faithful, who will** not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also **make a way to escape**, that ye may be able to bear it.
- 2 Corinthians 10:4 (For <u>the weapons of our warfare are</u> <u>not carnal</u>, but <u>mighty through God</u> to the pulling down of strong holds;)
- 2 Corinthians 10:5 <u>Casting down imaginations</u>, and <u>every high thing</u> that <u>exalteth itself against the knowledge of God</u>, and <u>bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;</u>

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but <u>against principalities</u>, <u>against powers</u>, <u>against the rulers of the darkness of this world</u>, <u>against spiritual</u> wickedness in high places.

- 1 John 4:1 Beloved, <u>believe not every spirit</u>, but <u>try the spirits whether they are of God</u>: because <u>many false prophets are gone out into the world</u>.
- 1 John 4:4 <u>Ye are of God</u>, little children, <u>and have overcome</u> them: because <u>greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world</u>.
- 1 John 1:9 If we <u>confess our sins</u>, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and <u>to cleanse us from all</u> <u>unrighteousness</u>.

James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and **he will flee from you**.

- 2 Samuel 22:2 And he said, <u>The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer</u>;
- 2 Samuel 22:4 I will call on the LORD, who is worthy to be praised: **so shall I be saved from mine enemies**.

Colossians 1:13 Who hath <u>delivered us from the power of</u> <u>darkness</u>, and hath translated us <u>into the kingdom of his</u> dear Son:

Colossians 2:15 And having **spoiled principalities and powers**, he made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

Deuteronomy 3:22 Ye shall not fear them: for **the LORD your God he shall fight for you**.

Deuteronomy 9:3 Understand therefore this day, that the LORD thy God is he which goeth over before thee; as <u>a consuming fire he shall destroy them</u>, and he shall <u>bring them down before thy face</u>: so shalt thou <u>drive them out</u>, and <u>destroy them quickly</u>, as the LORD hath said unto thee.

Deuteronomy 20:4 For the LORD your God is he that goeth with you, to fight for you against your enemies, to save you.

Joshua 10:8 And the LORD said unto Joshua, Fear them not: for <u>I have delivered them into thine hand</u>; <u>there shall</u> not a man of them stand before thee.

Joshua 23:10 **One man of you shall chase a thousand**: for the LORD your God, he it is that fighteth for you, as he hath promised you.

Psalms 108:13 Through God we shall do valiantly: for <u>he it</u> is that shall tread down our enemies.

Proverbs 21:31 The horse is prepared against the day of battle: but **safety is of the LORD**.

Proverbs 26:2 As the bird by wandering, as the swallow by flying, so the curse causeless shall not come.

Isaiah 41:13 For I the LORD thy God will hold thy right hand, saying unto thee, Fear not; I will help thee.

Isaiah 45:5 <u>I am the LORD</u>, and there is none else, <u>there is</u> no God beside me: <u>I girded thee</u>, though thou hast not known me:

Isaiah 54:17 No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, saith the LORD.

Nahum 1:7 The LORD is good, <u>a strong hold in the day of trouble</u>; and he knoweth them that trust in him.

Mark 16:18 <u>They shall take up serpents</u>; and <u>if they drink</u> any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; <u>they shall lay hands</u> on the sick, and they shall recover.

Ephesians 6:10 Finally, my brethren, <u>be strong in the Lord</u>, and in the power of his might.

Ephesians 6:13 Wherefore <u>take unto you the whole</u> <u>armour of God</u>, that ye may be able to <u>withstand in the</u> <u>evil day</u>, and having done all, to stand.

Exodus 15:3 <u>The LORD is a man of war: the LORD is his</u> name.

Numbers 23:23 Surely there is no enchantment against Jacob, neither is there any divination against Israel: according to this time it shall be said of Jacob and of Israel, What hath God wrought!

Deuteronomy 28:7 <u>The LORD shall cause thine enemies</u> that rise up against thee <u>to be smitten before thy face</u>: they shall come out against thee one way, and flee before thee seven ways.

Joshua 1:5 There shall not any man be able to stand before thee all the days of thy life: as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee: I will not fail thee, nor forsake thee.

1 Samuel 14:6 And Jonathan said to the young man that bare his armour, Come, and let us go over unto the garrison of these uncircumcised: it may be that the LORD will work for us: for there is no restraint to the LORD to save by many or by few.

1 Samuel 17:47 And all this assembly shall know that <u>the LORD</u> saveth not with sword and spear: for <u>the battle is the LORD'S</u>, and he will give you into our hands.

2 Kings 6:16 And he answered, <u>Fear not: for they that be with us are more than they that be with them.</u>

2 Chronicles 20:15 And he said, Hearken ye, all Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem, and thou king Jehoshaphat, Thus saith the LORD unto you, <u>Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, but God's.</u>

2 Chronicles 20:22 And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten.

2 Chronicles 32:7 <u>Be strong and courageous, be not afraid nor dismayed</u> for the king of Assyria, nor <u>for all the multitude that is with him:</u> for there be more with us than with him:

2 Chronicles 32:8 With him is an arm of flesh; but with us is the LORD our God to help us, and to fight our battles. And the people rested themselves upon the words of Hezekiah king of Judah.

Psalms 21:9 Thou shalt <u>make them as a fiery oven</u> in the time of thine anger: the LORD shall <u>swallow them up in his</u> wrath, and the fire shall devour them.

Psalms 34:7 <u>The angel of the LORD encampeth round about them</u> that fear him, <u>and delivereth them</u>.

Psalms 44:5 <u>Through thee will we **push down our enemies**</u>: through thy name will we **tread them under** that rise up against us.

Psalms 68:1 <u>Let God arise, let his enemies be scattered</u>: let them also that hate him **flee before him**.

Psalms 118:10 All nations compassed me about: but <u>in the name of the LORD will I destroy them</u>.

Isaiah 14:21 <u>Prepare slaughter for his children</u> for the iniquity of their fathers; that they <u>do not rise</u>, <u>nor possess</u> <u>the land</u>, <u>nor fill the face of the world with cities</u>.

Isaiah 43:2 When thou passest through the waters, <u>I will be with thee</u>; and through the rivers, <u>they shall not overflow thee</u>: <u>when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned</u>; <u>neither shall the flame kindle upon thee</u>.

Isaiah 54:15 Behold, they shall surely gather together, but not by me: whosoever shall gather together against thee shall fall for thy sake.

Isaiah 58:6 Is not this the fast that I have chosen? to <u>loose</u> <u>the bands of wickedness</u>, to <u>undo the heavy burdens</u>, and to <u>let the oppressed go free</u>, and that ye <u>break every</u> <u>yoke</u>?

Jeremiah 23:29 <u>Is not my word like as a fire</u>? saith the LORD; and like <u>a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces</u>?

Jeremiah 30:23 Behold, the whirlwind of the LORD goeth forth with fury, a continuing whirlwind: it shall fall with pain upon the head of the wicked.

Matthew 11:12 And from the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven suffereth violence, and the violent take it by force.

Hebrews 11:33 Who <u>through faith subdued kingdoms</u>, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, <u>stopped the</u> <u>mouths of lions</u>,

Hebrews 11:34 Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, <u>out of weakness were made strong</u>, <u>waxed valiant in fight</u>, <u>turned to flight the armies of the aliens</u>.

Revelation 2:26 And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

Revelation 2:27 And <u>he shall rule them with a rod of iron;</u> as the vessels of a potter shall they be **broken to shivers**: even as I received of my Father

Revelation 5:10 And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.

Revelation 19:15 And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it he should smite the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

Exodus 22:18 Thou shalt not suffer a witch to live.

Leviticus 20:6 And the soul that turneth after such as have familiar spirits, and after wizards, to go a whoring after them, will even set my face against that soul, and will cut him off from among his people.

Leviticus 20:27 A man also or woman that hath a familiar spirit, or that is a wizard, shall surely be put to death: they shall stone them with stones: their blood shall be upon them.

Deuteronomy 7:26 <u>Neither shalt thou bring an</u> <u>abomination into thine house, lest thou be a cursed thing like it</u>: but thou shalt utterly detest it, and thou shalt utterly abhor it; for it is a cursed thing.

Deuteronomy 18:12 For <u>all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD</u>: and because of these abominations <u>the LORD</u> thy God doth drive them out from before thee.

Joshua 1:3 Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses.

1 Samuel 14:15 And there was <u>trembling in the host</u>, in the <u>field</u>, and <u>among all the people</u>: the garrison, and the spoilers, <u>they also trembled</u>, and <u>the earth quaked</u>: so <u>it</u> <u>was a very great trembling</u>.

1 Samuel 14:16 And the watchmen of Saul in Gibeah of Benjamin looked; and, behold, the multitude melted away, and they went on beating down one another.

Job 22:28 <u>Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee</u>: and the light shall shine upon thy ways.

Psalms 8:6 Thou madest him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all things under his feet:

Psalms 11:6 Upon the wicked he shall rain snares, fire and brimstone, and an horrible tempest: this shall be the portion of their cup.

Psalms 35:1 <u>Plead my cause</u>, O LORD, with them that strive with me: <u>fight against them that fight against me</u>.

Psalms 35:2 Take hold of shield and buckler, and **stand up for mine help**.

Psalms 35:3 <u>Draw out also the spear</u>, and <u>stop the way</u> <u>against them that persecute me</u>: say unto my soul, I am thy salvation.

Psalms 35:4 <u>Let them be confounded and put to shame</u> that seek after my soul: let them <u>be turned back and</u> brought to confusion that devise my hurt.

Psalms 35:5 <u>Let them be as chaff before the wind</u>: and <u>let the angel of the LORD chase them</u>.

Psalms 35:6 <u>Let their way be dark and slippery</u>: and <u>let the angel of the LORD persecute them.</u>

Psalms 35:7 For <u>without cause</u> have they hid for me their net in a pit, which <u>without cause</u> they have digged for my soul.

Psalms 35:8 <u>Let destruction come upon him at unawares</u>; and <u>let his net that he hath hid catch himself</u>: <u>into that very</u> destruction **let him fall**.

Psalms 35:26 Let them <u>be ashamed and brought to</u> <u>confusion together that rejoice at mine hurt</u>: let them <u>be</u> <u>clothed with shame and dishonour</u> that magnify themselves against me.

Psalms 107:12 Therefore <u>he brought down their heart with labour; they fell down, and there was none to help.</u>

Proverbs 17:11 An evil man seeketh only rebellion: therefore a cruel messenger shall be sent against him.

Proverbs 18:21 <u>Death and life are in the power of the tongue</u>: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof. Isaiah 9:5 <u>For every battle of the warrior</u> is with confused noise, and garments rolled in blood; but this shall <u>be with burning and fuel of fire</u>.

Isaiah 14:23 I will also make it a possession for the bittern, and pools of water: and <u>I will sweep it with the besom of destruction</u>, saith the LORD of hosts.

Isaiah 45:11 Thus saith the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, and his Maker, <u>Ask me of things to come</u> concerning my sons, and <u>concerning the work of my hands command ye me</u>.

Isaiah 47:11 Therefore shall <u>evil come upon thee</u>; <u>thou</u> <u>shalt not know from whence it riseth</u>: and <u>mischief shall fall</u> <u>upon thee</u>; <u>thou shalt not be able to put it off</u>: and <u>desolation shall come upon thee suddenly</u>, which thou shalt not know.

Isaiah 47:15 Thus shall they be unto thee with whom thou hast laboured, even thy merchants, from thy youth: they-shall wander every-one-to-his quarter; none shall save thee.

Isaiah 63:10 But they rebelled, and vexed his holy Spirit: therefore he was turned to be their enemy, and he fought against them.

Jeremiah 1:10 See, I have this day set thee over the nations and over the kingdoms, to **root out**, and to **pull down**, and to **destroy**, and to **throw down**, to build, and to plant.

Jeremiah 51:20 Thou art my battle axe and weapons of war: for with thee will I break in pieces the nations, and with thee will I destroy kingdoms;

Nahum 3:1 <u>Woe to the bloody city</u>! it is all full of lies and robbery; the prey departeth not; ... 4 Because of the multitude of the whoredoms of the wellfavoured harlot, the mistress of witchcrafts, <u>that selleth nations</u> through her whoredoms, <u>and families through her witchcrafts</u>.

Matthew 7:7 Ask, and <u>it shall be given you</u>; seek, and <u>ye shall find</u>; knock, and <u>it shall be opened unto you</u>:

Matthew 7:8 For <u>every one that asketh receiveth</u>; and <u>he</u>

that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Matthew 12:29 Or else how can one enter into a strong man's house, and spoil his goods, except he <u>first bind the</u> **strong man?** and then he will **spoil his house**.

Matthew 16:18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock <u>I will build my church</u>; and <u>the gates of</u> hell shall not prevail against it.

Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee <u>the keys of the kingdom of heaven</u>: and whatsoever thou shalt <u>bind on earth</u> shall be <u>bound in heaven</u>: and whatsoever thou shalt <u>loose on earth</u> shall be <u>loosed in heaven</u>.

Matthew 18:18 Verily I say unto you, <u>Whatsoever ye shall</u> bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and <u>whatsoever</u> ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Matthew 18:19 Again I say unto you, That if <u>two of you shall</u> <u>agree on earth as touching any thing</u> that they shall ask, <u>it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven</u>.

Matthew 26:53 Thinkest thou that I cannot now pray to my Father, and <u>he shall presently give me more than twelve</u> <u>legions of angels?</u>

Mark 11:23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, **Be thou removed**, and **be thou cast into the sea**; and **shall not doubt** in his heart, **but shall believe** that those things which he saith shall come to pass; **he shall have whatsoever he saith**.

Mark 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, **believe that ye receive them**, and **ye** shall **have them**.

Luke 10:17 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name.

Luke 16:16 The law and the prophets were until John: since that time the kingdom of God is preached, and every man presseth into it.

John 14:14 If <u>ye shall ask any thing</u> in my name, <u>I will do it</u>. Romans 14:11 For it is written, <u>As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.</u>

1 Corinthians 6:17 But <u>he that is joined unto the Lord **is one spirit**</u>.

Galatians 3:1 O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?

Ephesians 1:21 <u>Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion</u>, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

Ephesians 6:16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

Ephesians 6:17 And take <u>the helmet of salvation</u>, and <u>the sword of the Spirit</u>, which is <u>the word of God</u>:

Hebrews 1:13 But to which of the angels said he at any time, Sit on my right hand, until <u>I make thine enemies thy</u> footstool?

Hebrews 1:14 Are they not all <u>ministering spirits</u>, sent forth to <u>minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation</u>?

James 1:6 But let him <u>ask in faith, nothing wavering</u>. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed.

1 John 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

1 John 5:14 And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us:

Revelation 3:8 I know thy works: behold, <u>I have set before</u> thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.

Revelation 12:4 And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.

Revelation 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night.

Revelation 12:11 And they <u>overcame him by the blood of</u> <u>the Lamb</u>, and <u>by the word of their testimony</u>; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

Psalms 18:34 He <u>teacheth my hands to war</u>, so that <u>a bow</u> of steel is broken by mine arms.

Psalms 37:17 For the <u>arms of the wicked shall be broken</u>: but the LORD upholdeth the righteous.

Psalms 104:4 Who maketh his angels spirits; **his ministers a flaming fire**:

Psalms 121:6 The **sun shall not smite thee** by day, nor the moon by night.

Psalms 144:1 Blessed be <u>the LORD my strength</u>, which <u>teacheth my hands to war</u>, and <u>my fingers to fight</u>:

Psalms 149:6 Let <u>the high praises of God</u> be <u>in their mouth</u>, and <u>a twoedged sword in their hand</u>;

Psalms 149:7 To execute vengeance upon the heathen, and punishments upon the people;

Psalms 149:8 To **bind their kings with chains**, and their nobles **with fetters of iron**;

Psalms 149:9 <u>To execute upon them the judgment</u> <u>written</u>: this honour have all his saints. Praise ye the LORD.

Hebrews 12:29 For our God is a consuming fire.
