# **BELIEVE THAT JESUS IS GOD**

Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.

John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

John 1:18 No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.

John 14:9 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Show us the Father?

John 20:28 And Thomas answered and said unto him, My Lord and my God.

Acts 20:28 Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.

Romans 9:5 Whose are the fathers, and of whom as concerning the flesh Christ came, who is over all, God blessed for ever. Amen.

Philippians 2:6 Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

Colossians 2:9 For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.

1 Timothy 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

Titus 2:13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ; Hebrews 1:8 But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom.

2 Peter 1:1 Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ:

1 John 5:20 And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.

Exodus 3:14 And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

John 8:58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.

Matthew 2:11 And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother, and fell down, and worshipped him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts; gold, and frankincense, and myrrh.

Matthew 8:2 And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.

Matthew 9:18 While he spake these things unto them, behold, there came a certain ruler, and worshipped him, saying, My daughter is even now dead: but come and lay thy hand upon her, and she shall live.

Luke 23:42 And he said unto Jesus, Lord, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom.

Luke 24:52 And they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy:

John 9:38 And he said, Lord, I believe. And he worshipped him.

Hebrews 1:6 And again, when he bringeth in the firstbegotten into the world, he saith, And let all the angels of God worship him.

Luke 12:8 Also I say unto you, Whosoever shall confess me before men, him shall the Son of man also confess before the angels of God:

Luke 12:9 But he that denieth me before men shall be denied before the angels of God.

John 17:5 And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.

John 17:21 That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me.

Acts 10:36 The word which God sent unto the children of Israel, preaching peace by Jesus Christ: (he is Lord of all:)

Romans 8:32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

Romans 10:9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.

Romans 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Romans 14:10 But why dost thou judge thy brother? or why dost thou set at nought thy brother? for we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ.

1 Corinthians 10:4 And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Christ.

1 Corinthians 15:47 The first man is of the earth, earthy: the second man is the Lord from heaven.

Philippians 2:9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

Colossians 1:16 For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:

Colossians 1:17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.

1 Peter 1:11 Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow.

Revelation 3:14 And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God;

### THE ETERNAL HUMAN SPIRIT

Ecclesiastes 12:7 Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it.

Matthew 25:46 And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the righteous into life eternal.

Romans 2:29 But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God.

- 1 Corinthians 14:14 For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful.
- 1 Corinthians 14:15 What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also.
- 1 Corinthians 14:16 Else when thou shalt bless with the spirit, how shall he that occupieth the room of the unlearned say Amen at thy giving of thanks, seeing he understandeth not what thou sayest?

Galatians 6:18 Brethren, the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen.

Philippians 1:23 For I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Christ; which is far better:

Hebrews 12:9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live?

Hebrews 12:23 To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect,

1 John 4:1 Beloved, believe not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world.

### RECEIVE THE SPIRIT

John 1:12 But <u>as many as received him</u>, to them gave he <u>power</u> to become the sons of God, even to them that <u>believe on his</u> name:

John 7:39 (But this **spake he of the Spirit**, which **they that believe on him should receive**: for **the Holy Ghost was not yet given**; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)

John 14:17 **Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive**, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

John 20:22 And when he had said this, he breathed on them, and saith unto them, Receive ye the Holy Ghost:

Acts 1:8 But <u>ye shall receive power</u>, **after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you**: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Acts 2:33 Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.

Acts 2:38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Acts 8:15 Who, when they were come down, **prayed for them**, that **they might receive the Holy Ghost**:

Acts 8:17 Then laid they their hands on them, and they received the Holy Ghost.

Acts 8:18 And when Simon saw that through laying on of the apostles' hands the Holy Ghost was given, he offered them money,

Acts 8:19 Saying, Give me also this power, that **on whomsoever I** lay hands, he may receive the Holy Ghost.

Acts 9:17 And Ananias went his way, and entered into the house; and <u>putting his hands on him</u> said, Brother Saul, the Lord, even Jesus, that appeared unto thee in the way as thou camest, hath sent me, that <u>thou mightest</u> receive thy sight, and <u>be filled with the Holy Ghost</u>.

Acts 10:47 Can any man forbid water, that these should not be baptized, which have received the Holy Ghost as well as we?

Acts 19:2 He said unto them, <u>Have ye received the Holy Ghost</u> <u>since ye believed</u>? And they said unto him, <u>We have not so much as heard</u> whether there be any Holy Ghost.

Acts 19:6 And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues, and prophesied.

Romans 8:15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but **ye have received the Spirit of adoption**, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

- 1 Corinthians 2:12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.
- 1 Corinthians 2:14 But <u>the natural man receiveth not the things</u> <u>of the Spirit of God</u>: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because <u>they are spiritually discerned</u>.

Galatians 1:12 For I neither received it of man, <u>neither was I taught</u> it, but **by the revelation of Jesus Christ**.

Galatians 3:2 This only would I learn of you, **Received ye the Spirit** by the works of the law, or **by the hearing of faith**?

Galatians 3:14 That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

### STAY IN THE SPIRIT

Luke 1:17 And he shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord.

John 11:33 When Jesus therefore saw her weeping, and the Jews also weeping which came with her, he groaned in the spirit, and was troubled,

Acts 18:5 And when Silas and Timotheus were come from Macedonia, Paul was pressed in the spirit, and testified to the Jews that Jesus was Christ.

Acts 18:25 This man was instructed in the way of the Lord; and being **fervent** in **the spirit**, he spake and taught diligently the things of the Lord, knowing only the baptism of John.

Acts 19:21 After these things were ended, Paul purposed in the **spirit**, when he had passed through Macedonia and Achaia, to go to Jerusalem, saying, After I have been there, I must also see Rome.

Acts 20:22 And now, behold, <u>I go **bound in the spirit**</u> unto Jerusalem, not knowing the things that shall befall me there:

Romans 2:29 But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, **in the spirit**, and not in the letter; whose praise is <u>not of men</u>, but **of God**.

Romans 8:9 But <u>ye are not in the flesh, but **in the Spirit**</u>, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now <u>if any man have not the</u> Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.

Romans 9:1 I say the truth in Christ, I lie not, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Ghost,

Romans 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.

1 Corinthians 14:2 For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit **in the spirit he speaketh mysteries**.

Galatians 3:3 Are ye so foolish? <u>having **begun in the Spirit**</u>, are ye now made perfect by the flesh?

Galatians 5:16 This I say then, **Walk in the Spirit**, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

Galatians 5:25 <u>If we live in the Spirit</u>, let us also <u>walk in the Spirit</u>.

Ephesians 4:23 And be renewed in the spirit of your mind;

Ephesians 6:18 Praying always with all <u>prayer and supplication in</u> <u>the Spirit</u>, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

Philippians 3:3 For we are the circumcision, which worship **God** in **the spirit**, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh.

Colossians 1:8 Who also declared unto us your love in the Spirit.

Colossians 2:5 For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am <u>I with</u> <u>you in the spirit</u>, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your faith in Christ.

Jude 1:20 But ye, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost,

Revelation 1:10 <u>I was in the Spirit</u> on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,

Revelation 4:2 And <u>immediately I was in the spirit</u>; and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the throne.

Revelation 17:3 So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit upon a scarlet coloured beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.

Revelation 21:10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,

### **BE INSTRUCTED BY THE SPIRIT**

Matthew 10:20 For it is not ye that speak, but the Spirit of your Father which speaketh in you.

Matthew 22:29 Jesus answered and said unto them, <u>Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God</u>.

Mark 12:24 And Jesus answering said unto them, <u>Do ye not</u> therefore err, because ye know not the scriptures, neither the power of God?

Mark 13:11 But when they shall lead you, and deliver you up, take no thought beforehand what ye shall speak, neither do ye premeditate: but whatsoever shall be given you in that hour, that speak ye: for it is not ye that speak, but the Holy Ghost.

Luke 4:18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

Luke 12:12 For the Holy Ghost shall teach you in the same hour what ye ought to say.

John 3:34 For he whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto him.

John 6:45 It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of God. Every man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me.

John 6:63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.

John 14:26 But the Comforter, which is **the Holy Ghost**, whom the Father will send in my name, **he shall teach you all things**, and **bring all things to your remembrance**, whatsoever I have said unto you.

John 15:26 But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, **even the Spirit of truth**, which proceedeth from the Father, **he shall testify of me**:

John 16:13 Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will show you things to come.

Acts 6:10 And they were not able to resist the wisdom and the spirit by which he spake.

Acts 8:29 Then the Spirit said unto Philip, Go near, and join thyself to this chariot.

Acts 10:19 While Peter thought on the vision, the Spirit said unto him, Behold, three men seek thee.

Acts 10:38 How <u>God anointed Jesus</u> of Nazareth <u>with the Holy Ghost</u> and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Acts 21:4 And finding disciples, we tarried there seven days: who said to Paul through the Spirit, that he should not go up to Jerusalem.

Romans 15:19 Through mighty signs and wonders, **by the power of the Spirit of God**; so that from Jerusalem, and round about unto Illyricum, I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.

Romans 16:25 Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to **the revelation of the mystery**, which was kept secret since the world began,

- 1 Corinthians 2:4 And <u>my speech and my preaching</u> was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but <u>in</u> <u>demonstration of the Spirit and of power</u>:
- 1 Corinthians 2:5 That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.
- 1 Corinthians 2:10 But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.
- 1 Corinthians 2:11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so **the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God**.
- 1 Corinthians 2:13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.
- 1 Corinthians 4:20 For the kingdom of God is **not in word**, **but in power**.
- 1 Corinthians 14:6 Now, brethren, if I come unto you speaking with tongues, what shall I profit you, except I shall speak to you either by revelation, or by knowledge, or by prophesying, or by doctrine?
- 1 Corinthians 14:26 How is it then, brethren? when ye come together, **every one of you** hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, **hath a revelation**, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto edifying.
- 2 Corinthians 1:21 Now he which stablisheth us with you in Christ, and **hath anointed us**, **is God**;
- 2 Corinthians 12:1 It is not expedient for me doubtless to glory. I will come to visions and revelations of the Lord.

Galatians 2:2 And <u>I went up by revelation</u>, and <u>communicated unto them</u> that gospel which I preach among the Gentiles, but privately to them which were of reputation, lest by any means I should run, or had run, in vain.

Ephesians 1:17 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you **the spirit of wisdom and revelation** in the knowledge of him:

Ephesians 3:3 How that **by revelation he made known unto me the mystery**; (as I wrote afore in few words,

Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; **teaching** and admonishing **one another in** psalms and hymns and **spiritual songs**, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

1 Thessalonians 1:5 For <u>our gospel came</u> not unto you in word only, but also in power, and <u>in the Holy Ghost</u>, and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.

Hebrews 1:9 Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.

Hebrews 5:12 For when for the time <u>ye ought to be</u> <u>teachers</u>, <u>ye have need that one teach you again which be</u> <u>the first principles of the oracles of God</u>; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat.

James 4:5 Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain, **The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy**?

1 Peter 1:11 Searching what, or what manner of time <u>the</u> Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it <u>testified beforehand</u> the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow.

- 1 Peter 4:14 If ye be reproached for the name of Christ, happy are ye; for the spirit of glory and of God resteth upon you: on their part he is evil spoken of, but on your part he is glorified.
- 2 Peter 1:18 And this voice which came from heaven we heard, when we were with him in the holy mount.
- 1 John 2:20 But <u>ye have an unction</u> from the Holy One, and <u>ye know all things</u>.
- 1 John 2:27 But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and <u>ye need not that any man teach you</u>: but as <u>the same anointing teacheth you of all things</u>, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.
- 1 John 4:2 Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God:
- 1 John 4:6 We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error.
- 1 John 5:6 This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth.
- 1 John 5:8 And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one.
- Jude 1:19 These be they who <u>separate themselves</u>, <u>sensual</u>, <u>having not the Spirit</u>.

### **BE LED BY THE SPIRIT**

Matthew 4:1 Then was Jesus <u>led up of the Spirit</u> into the <u>wilderness</u> to be tempted of the devil.

Matthew 12:28 But if <u>I cast out devils by the Spirit of God</u>, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.

Mark 1:12 And immediately **the Spirit driveth him** into the wilderness.

Mark 12:36 For <u>David himself</u> said by the Holy Ghost, The LORD said to my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool.

Luke 2:26 And it was revealed unto him by the Holy Ghost, that he should not see death, before he had seen the Lord's Christ.

Luke 2:27 And he came by the Spirit into the temple: and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him after the custom of the law,

Luke 4:1 And Jesus **being full of the Holy Ghost returned** from Jordan, and was **led by the Spirit** into the wilderness,

Luke 4:14 And Jesus <u>returned</u> in the <u>power of the Spirit</u> into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about.

Acts 11:28 And there stood up one of them named Agabus, and **signified by the Spirit** that there should be great dearth throughout all the world: which came to pass in the days of Claudius Caesar.

Acts 13:4 So they, being sent forth by the Holy Ghost, departed unto Seleucia; and from thence they sailed to Cyprus.

Romans 8:14 For <u>as many as **are led by the Spirit of God**, they are the sons of God.</u>

### BE CHANGED BY THE HOLY GHOST

- 1 Corinthians 12:3 Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.
- 1 Corinthians 12:8 For to one is given by the Spirit the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit;
- 2 Corinthians 3:18 But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.
- 2 Corinthians 6:6 By pureness, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness, by the Holy Ghost, by love unfeigned,
- Ephesians 3:5 Which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit;
- 2 Timothy 1:14 That good thing which was committed unto thee keep by the Holy Ghost which dwelleth in us.
- 1 Peter 3:18 For Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit:
- 2 Peter 1:21 For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.
- 1 John 3:24 And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.

### **GET THE POWER OF THE HOLY GHOST**

Matthew 1:18 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost.

Matthew 1:20 But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

Matthew 3:11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:

Matthew 12:31 Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of <u>sin</u> and <u>blasphemy</u> shall be forgiven unto men: but the <u>blasphemy against the Holy Ghost</u> shall not be forgiven unto men.

Matthew 12:32 And whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but <u>whosoever</u> **speaketh against the Holy Ghost**, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come.

Matthew 28:19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, **baptizing them in the name of** the Father, and of the Son, and of **the Holy Ghost**:

Mark 1:8 I indeed have baptized you with water: but <u>he shall</u> baptize you with the Holy Ghost.

Mark 3:29 But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation:

Luke 1:15 For he shall be great in the sight of the Lord, and shall drink neither wine nor strong drink; and <u>he shall be filled with the Holy Ghost</u>, even from his mother's womb.

Luke 1:35 And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.

Luke 1:41 And it came to pass, that, when Elisabeth heard the salutation of Mary, the babe leaped in her womb; and Elisabeth was filled with the Holy Ghost:

Luke 1:67 And his father **Zacharias was filled with the Holy Ghost, and prophesied**, saying,

Luke 2:25 And, behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon; and the same man was <u>just and devout</u>, waiting for the consolation of Israel: and <u>the Holy Ghost was upon him</u>.

Luke 3:16 John answered, saying unto them all, <u>I indeed baptize you with water</u>; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: <u>he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire</u>:

Luke 3:22 And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.

Luke 12:10 And whosoever shall speak a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but unto <u>him that</u> <u>blasphemeth against the Holy Ghost</u> it shall not be forgiven.

John 1:33 And I knew him not: but <u>he that sent me to baptize</u> with water, the same said unto me, <u>Upon whom thou shalt</u> see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Ghost.

Acts 1:2 Until the day in which he was taken up, after that **he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments** unto the apostles whom he had chosen:

Acts 1:5 For John truly baptized with water; but <u>ye shall be</u> baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.

Acts 1:16 Men and brethren, this scripture <u>must needs have</u> been fulfilled, which the Holy Ghost by the mouth of <u>David spake</u> before concerning Judas, which was guide to them that took Jesus.

Acts 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Acts 4:8 Then Peter, <u>filled with the Holy Ghost</u>, said unto them, Ye rulers of the people, and elders of Israel,

Acts 4:31 And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness.

Acts 5:3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land?

Acts 5:32 And we are his witnesses of these things; and **so is also the Holy Ghost**, whom God hath given to them that obey him.

Acts 6:3 Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, **full of the Holy Ghost** and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business.

Acts 6:5 And the saying pleased the whole multitude: and they chose **Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Ghost**, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolas a proselyte of Antioch:

Acts 7:51 Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, **ye do always resist the Holy Ghost**: as your fathers did, so do ye.

Acts 7:55 But he, **being full of the Holy Ghost**, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and <u>saw the glory of God</u>, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God,

Acts 9:31 Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.

Acts 10:44 While Peter <u>yet spake these words</u>, **the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word**.

Acts 10:45 And they of the circumcision which believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that <u>on</u> the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Acts 11:15 And as I began to speak, the Holy Ghost fell on them, as on us at the beginning.

Acts 11:16 Then remembered I the word of the Lord, how that he said, <u>John indeed baptized with water; but **ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost.**</u>

Acts 11:24 For he was a good man, and full of the Holy Ghost and of faith: and much people was added unto the Lord.

Acts 13:2 As they ministered to the Lord, and fasted, **the Holy Ghost said**, Separate me Barnabas and Saul for the work whereunto I have called them.

Acts 13:9 Then Saul, (who also is called Paul,) **filled with the Holy Ghost**, set his eyes on him,

Acts 13:52 And the disciples were filled with joy, and with the Holy Ghost.

Acts 15:8 And <u>God</u>, which knoweth the hearts, <u>bare them</u> <u>witness</u>, <u>giving them the Holy Ghost</u>, even as he did unto us;

Acts 15:28 For <u>it seemed good to the Holy Ghost, and to us</u>, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things;

Acts 16:6 Now when they had gone throughout Phrygia and the region of Galatia, and were forbidden of the Holy Ghost to preach the word in Asia,

Acts 20:23 Save that **the Holy Ghost witnesseth in every city**, saying that bonds and afflictions abide me.

Acts 20:28 Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to <u>all</u> the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you <u>overseers</u>, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.

Acts 21:11 And when he was come unto us, he took Paul's girdle, and bound his own hands and feet, and said, Thus saith the Holy Ghost, So shall the Jews at Jerusalem bind the man that owneth this girdle, and shall deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles.

Acts 28:25 And when they agreed not among themselves, they departed, after that Paul had spoken one word, **Well spake the Holy Ghost by Esaias the prophet** unto our fathers,

Romans 5:5 And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

Romans 15:13 Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, **through** the power of the Holy Ghost.

Romans 15:16 That I should be the minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles, ministering the gospel of God, that the offering up of the Gentiles might be acceptable, being sanctified by the Holy Ghost.

- 2 Corinthians 13:14 The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen.
- 1 Thessalonians 1:6 And ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, <u>having received the word</u> in much affliction, <u>with</u> joy of the Holy Ghost:
- 1 Timothy 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: **God was** manifest in the flesh, **justified in the Spirit**, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

Titus 3:5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy <u>he saved us</u>, by the washing of regeneration, and <u>renewing of the Holy Ghost</u>;

Hebrews 2:4 <u>God also bearing them witness</u>, both <u>with</u> signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and <u>gifts of</u> <u>the Holy Ghost</u>, according to his own will?

Hebrews 3:7 Wherefore (as the Holy Ghost saith, To day if ye will hear his voice,

Hebrews 6:4 For it is impossible for those who were <u>once</u> <u>enlightened</u>, <u>and have tasted of the heavenly gift</u>, and <u>were made partakers of the Holy Ghost</u>,

Hebrews 9:8 **The Holy Ghost this signifying**, that the way into the holiest of all was not yet made manifest, while as the first tabernacle was yet standing:

Hebrews 10:15 Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before,

1 Peter 1:12 Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.

1 John 5:7 For there are <u>three that bear record in heaven</u>, the Father, the Word, and <u>the Holy Ghost</u>: and these three are one.

### LIVE IN THE SPIRIT

Matthew 3:16 And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:

Matthew 26:41 Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: **the spirit indeed is willing**, but the flesh is weak.

Mark 1:10 And straightway coming up out of the water, <u>he</u> saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon him:

Mark 14:38 Watch ye and pray, lest ye enter into temptation. **The spirit truly is ready**, but the flesh is weak.

John 1:32 And John bare record, saying, <u>I saw the Spirit</u> descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him.

John 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, **Except a man be born** of water and **of the Spirit**, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

John 3:6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

John 3:8 The <u>wind bloweth where it listeth</u>, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: **so is every one that is born of the Spirit**.

Acts 5:9 Then Peter said unto her, How is it that <u>ye have</u> <u>agreed together to tempt the Spirit of the Lord</u>? behold, the feet of them which have buried thy husband are at the door, and shall carry thee out.

Acts 8:39 And when they were come up out of the water, **the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip**, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing.

Acts 11:12 And the Spirit bade me go with them, nothing doubting. Moreover these six brethren accompanied me, and we entered into the man's house:

Acts 16:7 After they were come to Mysia, they assayed to go into Bithynia: but the Spirit suffered them not.

Romans 1:4 And declared to be the Son of God with power, **according to the spirit of holiness**, by the resurrection from the dead:

Romans 8:1 There is therefore now <u>no condemnation to</u> <u>them</u> which are in Christ Jesus, <u>who walk</u> not after the flesh, but <u>after the Spirit</u>.

Romans 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Romans 8:4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Romans 8:5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

Romans 8:10 And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but **the Spirit is life** because of righteousness.

Romans 8:11 But <u>if the Spirit of him</u> that <u>raised up Jesus</u> <u>from the dead</u> dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead <u>shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit</u> that dwelleth in you.

Romans 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, <u>ye shall die</u>: but <u>if</u> <u>ye through the Spirit</u> do mortify the deeds of the body, <u>ye</u> shall live.

Romans 8:16 The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

Romans 8:23 And not only they, but <u>ourselves also</u>, <u>which</u> <u>have the firstfruits of the Spirit</u>, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body.

Romans 8:26 <u>Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities</u>: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: <u>but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings</u> which cannot be uttered.

Romans 8:27 And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

Romans 15:30 Now <u>I beseech you, brethren</u>, for the Lord Jesus Christ's sake, and <u>for the love of the Spirit</u>, that ye strive together with me in your prayers to God for me;

- 1 Corinthians 3:16 Know ye not that <u>ye are the temple of God, and that **the Spirit of God dwelleth in you**?</u>
- 1 Corinthians 6:11 And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.
- 1 Corinthians 6:19 What? know ye not that **your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you**, which ye have of God, and **ye are not your own**?
- 1 Corinthians 7:40 But she is happier if she so abide, after my judgment: and I think also that <u>I have the Spirit of God</u>.
- 1 Corinthians 12:7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

- 1 Corinthians 14:15 What is it then? <u>I will pray with the spirit</u>, and I will pray with the understanding also: <u>I will sing with the spirit</u>, and I will sing with the understanding also.
- 1 Corinthians 14:16 Else <u>when thou shalt bless with the spirit</u>, how shall he that occupieth the room of the unlearned say Amen at thy giving of thanks, seeing he understandeth not what thou sayest?
- 2 Corinthians 1:22 Who hath also sealed us, and given the earnest of the Spirit in our hearts.
- 2 Corinthians 3:3 Forasmuch as ye are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, <u>written</u> not with ink, but <u>with the Spirit of the living God</u>; not in tables of stone, but <u>in fleshly tables of the heart</u>.
- 2 Corinthians 3:6 Who also hath made us **able ministers of the new testament**; not of the letter, but **of the spirit**: for the letter killeth, but **the spirit giveth life**.
- 2 Corinthians 3:8 How shall not the ministration of the spirit be rather glorious?
- 2 Corinthians 3:17 Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.
- 2 Corinthians 5:5 Now he that hath wrought us for the selfsame thing is **God**, who **also hath given unto us the earnest of the Spirit**.
- Galatians 3:5 <u>He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit</u>, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or **by the hearing of faith**?
- Galatians 4:6 And because ye are sons, <u>God hath sent</u> forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father

Galatians 4:29 But as then he that was born after the flesh persecuted him that was born after the Spirit, even so it is now.

Galatians 5:5 For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith.

Galatians 5:17 For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.

Galatians 5:18 But if **ye be led of the Spirit**, ye are not under the law.

Galatians 5:22 But **the fruit of the Spirit** is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,

Galatians 6:8 For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but <u>he that soweth to the Spirit shall</u> of the Spirit reap life everlasting.

Ephesians 2:2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:

Ephesians 2:22 In whom <u>ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the Spirit</u>.

Ephesians 4:3 Endeavouring to **keep the unity of the Spirit** in the bond of peace.

Ephesians 5:9 (For the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth;)

Ephesians 5:18 And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but **be filled with the Spirit**;

Ephesians 6:17 And <u>take</u> the helmet of salvation, and <u>the</u> <u>sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God</u>:

Philippians 1:19 For I know that this shall turn to <u>my</u> <u>salvation through</u> your prayer, and <u>the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ</u>,

Philippians 2:1 If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, <u>if any fellowship of the Spirit</u>, if any bowels and mercies,

- 1 Thessalonians 5:19 Quench not the Spirit.
- 2 Thessalonians 2:8 And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:
- 2 Thessalonians 2:13 But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because <u>God hath from the beginning chosen you</u> to salvation <u>through sanctification of the Spirit</u> and belief of the truth:
- 2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us **the spirit** of fear; but **of power, and of love, and of a sound mind**.

Hebrews 10:29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto **the Spirit of grace**?

- 1 Peter 1:2 Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied.
- 1 Peter 1:22 Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:

1 Peter 4:6 For for this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but <u>live according to God in the spirit</u>. Revelation 2:7 <u>He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith</u> unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the

Revelation 2:11 <u>He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith</u> unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death.

paradise of God.

Revelation 2:17 <u>He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith</u> unto the churches; To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth saving he that receiveth it.

Revelation 11:11 And after three days and an half **the Spirit** of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

Revelation 14:13 And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: **Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours**; and their works do follow them.

Revelation 19:10 And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, See thou do it not: I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy. Revelation 22:17 And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.
